



End-of Season Suggestions

Your Marshall equipment is designed with the most rugged electronics available, but these simple steps for storing your equipment during the off season, as outlined below, will help to extend the life of your tracking gear.

General

- It's always a good idea to clean and prep your gear for the summer months. Remove any dirt or debris from the prior season's hawking.
- Store your equipment in a cool and dry place, where they cannot accumulate dust, dirt or grime.

Transmitters

- Remove batteries from transmitters before storing and clean the battery contacts lightly with rubbing alcohol on a cotton swab. A cloth dampened with alcohol also works well to wipe down the exterior.
- Now's a great time to inspect your antennas and replace any that are kinked, damaged, or are showing exposed metal filaments

Receivers

- Important: Be sure to remove all batteries before putting your receiver away for the season. Failure to do this may result in battery leakage and swelling, which results in a serious issue to later fix.
- Store the unit in the padded holster or Desert Case, where the antenna and elements will be safe from damage.
- A wipe down of the receiver to remove dirt, especially from the moving antenna parts is good to do as well.

PocketLink and Rechargeable Batteries

- Fully charge your PocketLink, and rechargeable batteries prior to storing for the offseason.
- Then store all equipment in desert case in a cool and dry place.

Batteries

- All batteries should be stored in a cool and dry environment.
- Keep your batteries in a vapor-proof container if you are in a high-humidity environment or if there is risk of condensation. (Including in the fridge)
- Be sure to isolate all batteries so they do not come into contact with one another, which will create a short and damage the batteries or cause excess heat generation, this is especially important for 1/3N and all coin cell batteries (1225's, 1632's, 2032's, etc.)
